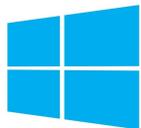
FIRST THING before launching Blackboard Collaborate



Chrome Settings

- ★ Go To Chrome Browser and click on the three dots in upper right hand corner of the browser next to your profile picture.
 1. Select 'Setting' in the drop down menu.
 2. Select 'privacy and security' on the left menu
 3. Select 'Site Settings' in the upper middle of page
 4. Open up Microphone and Camera from the list using the arrow on the right of each feature.
 5. Make sure that both features are turned on by the slider provided.
 6. Restart the browser again before selecting the BBC link

Windows 10

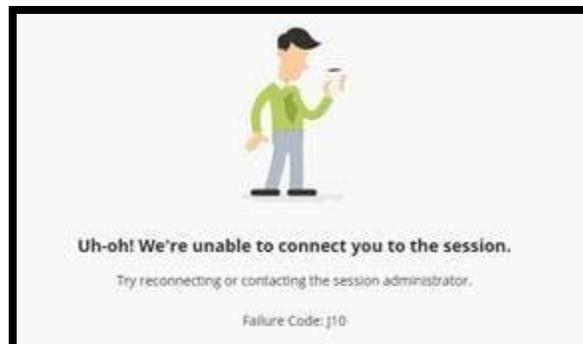
- ★ Go To Window Settings by typing "settings" in the windows search box (lower left taskbar).
 1. Select 'Setting App' on top of menu
 2. Select 'privacy' menu
 3. Open up Microphone and Camera from the list
 4. Make sure that both features are turned on by the slider provided.



- ★ The Blackboard Collaborate Link should be opened in Google Chrome.

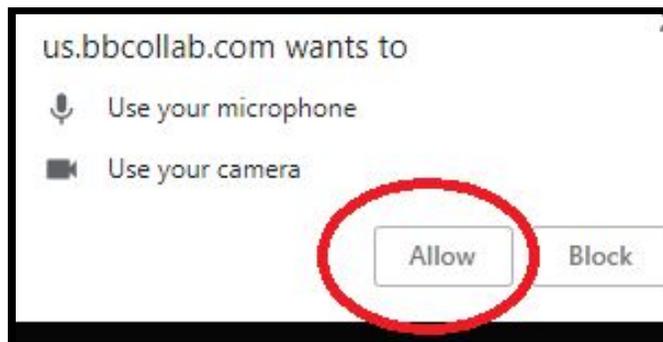


- ★ The first time you open it, **you might get an error message.** Refresh the page, and it should load.





- ★ You will need to pay attention to all the pop-ups like “allow mic” and “allow video.” If these don’t pop up, check to see if Chrome is blocking it.



★ **Having difficulty with your mic?**

- If you are using a plugin mic:
 - If plug-in, there is a dialog box that pops up as soon as you plug it in. Make sure it matches the type of device you are plugging in.
- If you are using the onboard mic:
 - Go to the search box in the bottom left of your screen
 - Type “device manager”
 - Plug in your credentials
 - Go to “Audio inputs and outputs”
 - Right click on “Microphone Array” to uninstall the audio devices
 - Restart your computer it will “build” the mic back in
