

DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNITY FLIERS FROM NON-PROFIT GROUPS FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) offers the opportunity for non-profit organizations to make their materials available to families. Each school principal has the option of how (and how frequently) they want to distribute to their individual school community.

During 2023-2024 school year, there will be four (4) opportunities for community non-profit groups (related to children/families and education) to distribute fliers in the Aldrin "Thursday Recorders" (student book bags). The four dates are listed below.

Groups may also set up tables at the Aldrin Back to School Night on Thursday, September 7, 2023.
